| 12:00 PM | <p><u>Triumvirate Environmental – Eric Chebator</u> Global Harmonization System (GHS) Presentation- OSHA has issued a final rule to align its Hazard Communication Standard with the Globally Harmonized System of Chemical Classification and Labeling (GHS).The final compliance date for the revised Hazard Communication Standard (HCS) is June 1st, 2016. This is the date by which OSHA says employers must be in complete compliance - update alternative workplace labeling and hazard communication program as necessary, and provide additional employee training for newly identified physical or health hazards. This presentation will cover: Global Harmonization System (GHS) Overview, regulatory requirements, Key Terms, Labeling, Hazard and Precautionary Statements, Safety Data Sheets (SDS), and Training Requirements.</p> |
