Subject: Training Sub-committee Report, February 2016

1. Spring 2016 Functional Exercise

- a. Planning is underway for the development and facilitation of a functional exercise by an outside vendor, which is tentatively scheduled for the October 2016 full membership fall training meeting. Preliminary project justification work has been completed and was submitted to NERAC for possible funding to hire a consultant to develop and facilitate the exercise based on the Situation Manual developed for the tabletop exercise conducted in December 2014 as well as the After Action Report / Improvement Plan. The planning committee is seeking interested individuals to participate on the exercise planning committee, which will work directly with the selected vendor to ensure the project is on point, meets the objectives of the planning committee and delivered on time. We still have several disciplines on the planning committee that need representation including EMS, Public Health, Healthcare, and government officials.
